### APPENDIX

### TOWN OF SEXSMITH

In township 73, range 6:

Firstly, the north-east quarter of section 24 lying west of the west limit of the road as shown on Plan 5439 J.Y.

Secondly, the south half and the north-east quarter of section 25 lying west of the road as shown on Plan 5439 J.Y. excluding the north-south government road allowance adjoining the west limit of the south-west quarter of section 25.

Thirdly, the south half of the north-west quarter of section 25 excluding thereout the north-south government road allowance adjoining the west limit of the south half of the north-west quarter of section 25.

Fourthly, all those portions of the original government road allowance lying between the north half of section 24 and the south half of section 25 and lying west of the production north and south across the said road allowance of the west limit of the road as shown on Plan 5439 J.Y.

All of the above described lands lying west of the sixth meridian.
