

Municipal Sustainability Strategy

The Government of Alberta is committed to the enhanced long-term viability and accountability of municipalities and their communities. As part of this commitment, Municipal Affairs, in consultation with rural and urban municipal associations, has developed the Municipal Sustainability Strategy (MSS) to improve the long-term viability for municipalities across the province.

The centerpiece of the strategy is an innovative municipal viability process which includes a self-assessment toolkit, a capacity building toolkit and a viability review.

Implementation includes ongoing consultation with the municipal associations and the development of necessary legislative changes to establish certain components of the municipal viability review process.
