

Private Sewage Installer Eligibility to Obtain PSDS Permits

Section 17 of the *Permit Regulation* (Alberta Regulation 204/2007) sets out certification and eligibility requirements of persons obtaining permits for a Private Sewage System.

Except for an owner who resides in a single family residential dwelling as allowed by the permit regulation, a person applying for a permit must be certified as a private sewage installer and provide evidence of having a valid PS or R-PS certificate of competency issued by Alberta Municipal Affairs.

A certificate having the letters “PS” preceding the certification number indicates qualification to obtain permits for all private sewage systems.

A certificate having the letters R-PS preceding the certification number has restrictions on their qualifications and may obtain permits within the scope of their certification; typically only sewage holding tanks. The letters R-PS designate Restricted Private Sewage. Restrictions are set out on the back of the certificate card.

The PS and R-PS certificates have an expiry date and must be renewed each year.
